Dedicated Hands-On Workshop Day

1. Laparoscopic Skills Training Workshop

This workshop focuses on core minimally invasive surgical competencies, including:

- Instrument handling and ergonomics
- Depth perception and camera navigation
- Suturing and knot-tying techniques in simulated environments
- Precision and coordination exercises

The session is designed to strengthen foundational laparoscopic skills relevant to general surgery, oncologic procedures, and surgical training pathways.

2. Flaps & Grafts Workshop

This workshop addresses reconstructive surgical principles, including:
